# Dance Classes

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

**Accelerated HipHop: (Teacher Placement)** Students are selected for more extensive training in Hip Hop.

**Acrobatics (Acro):** Class focus is on tumbling skills. This class combines limbers, tumbling & double tricks. An energetic class that is great for the student who likes to bounce, flip and bend!

**Ballet:** Learn classical positions, barre work, center floor, leaps & turns (Various levels). Westside offers a Ballet Company for more advanced students by teacher placement. Dancers participate in the Nutcracker each winter.

**Boys Class:** This is a high energy class. This class will focus on current dance moves with some structure on how to put movement together.

**Dance Express: (Teacher Placement)** An accelerated program for younger dancers. Includes classes in Tap, Jazz, and Tumble. Members perform locally.

**Flexibility (Flex):** A class designed for students interested in improving flexibility. An hour focused on safe stretching & increased muscle elasticity. Perfect for "getting your splits down"

**Hip Hop:** This high energy class highlights popular dance steps seen in current music videos. Music and dance moves are always age appropriate. Fast paced and fun! (Various ages and levels).

**Jazz:** This class includes the latest dance moves, flexibility, kicks, turns, leaps & dance routines. A great basis for school dance teams, theatre & cheer. Adult Jazz focuses on Broadway dance. (12+, various levels).

**Jazz Technique:** A technique class designed for our Accelerated Hip Hop and Acro students to improve their dance skills.

**Pointe & Pre-Pointe:** Teacher Placement classes. Students are required to take at least 2 advanced level Ballet classes in addition to their Pointe class.

**Pre-Ballet:** The perfect class for the younger student. This class emphasizes ballet positions, barre work, center floor, leaps & turns. (Various ages and levels).

**Pre-Ballet Express:** Some of our youngest ballerinas are invited to train at a more advanced level and participate in our winter Nutcracker performance. (Two levels.)

**Princess Ballet:** Students are introduced to ballet while discovering their inner princess! Music and movement are coordinated to popular princess music and themes. (Two levels).

**Tap/Jazz:** For both boys and girls, this combination class designed for our older students. A chance to progress in both tap and jazz skills. (Multiple levels).

**Tap/Jazz/Tumble:** Boys and girls ages 2 1/2 -10. Learn the joy of dance and tumbling in our most popular combination class (Various levels and ages).

**Tap/Princess Ballet (Pre-Ballet):** A favorite combination class. Students enjoy learning basic tap skills as well as basic ballet positions and technique.

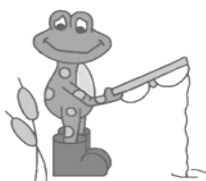

**Registration:** A one-time family membership fee of \$25.00, includes full membership & member discounts to all programs in the facility. There will be a \$10.00 re-start fee for any member that drops and wishes to re-register.

**Tuition:** Tuition is based on 48 weeks of classes per year, an average of 4 weeks of classes per month. *(Some months you will have 5 classes and some months you will have 3.)* Tuition is due by the first day of the month. Customers are encouraged to enroll in the Electronic Funds Transfer System (EFT) through their checking account. Customers not enrolled in the EFT program will automatically be charged a \$25.00 late fee for balances past due after the 1st of the month.

**Parking:** Do not park in front of the door, along the yellow painted curbs or along the fire lane. Remember: *Children cannot be seen behind or in front of a parked car.* For everyone's safety, please use designated parking spots! Do not park behind the Westside Academy vans, they make many trips during regular business hours.

**Missed Classes:** Students are required to schedule make-up classes through the office. We do not pro-rate for missed classes. Make-up classes cannot be substituted for tuition payments. Students may use open gym as a make-up. You must be currently enrolled to take a make-up and make-up classes must be taken within a 2 month period or all make-ups are forfeited.

**Adding, Dropping or Transferring Classes:** The customer is responsible for notifying the office of any changes to their child's enrollment. This will keep your records updated. Written notification is encouraged.

**NSF Payments:** A \$35.00 fee will be charged to your account for each transaction that is returned "insufficient funds."

**Notices:** In our on-going effort to keep parents informed of upcoming events, classroom activities and general academy information, we put out an academy notice the first week of each month. Notices are passed out during class. Please stop by the office if at any time you do not receive one. Don't forget to check out our website at [www.westsideacademy.com](http://www.westsideacademy.com) for important information.

**Lost & Found:** Please do not leave your personal items in the restroom. Westside Academy cannot be responsible for lost or stolen belongings. For those items left behind, we do have lost & found bins located in the restrooms.

**Gymnastics Viewing Area:** For our students safety as well as your own, we do not allow parents or students (not in class) to stand or sit in the gym during classes. The viewing area is designed for this purpose.

*If you bring additional siblings with you, they must stay with you! Westside Academy cannot be responsible for children who are not in classes. Dance classes have special quarterly Parent Watch Weeks for parents to observe their child's progress.*

**Parent Watch Week:** Parents of dance students are encouraged to attend watch week. You may bring your still and/or video camera. Our Summer Parent Watch Week date is August 24th-30th.

**Photos:** For the safety of our gymnasts, please do not take flash pictures or use video cameras with bright lights when taking pictures in the gym.
