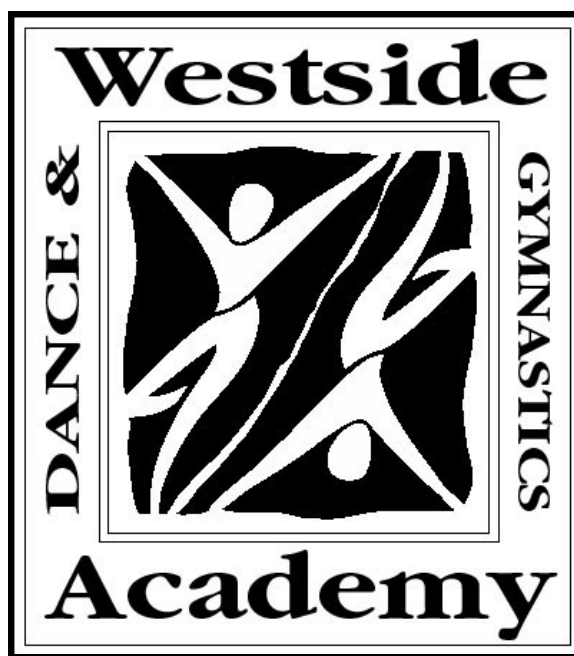

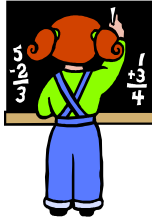

No Jewelry ~ Hair pulled back and off the neck

Acrobatics (Tumbling): Designed to teach the proper drills, progressions and flexibility training to students who want to learn basic Gymnastics and Acro skills for Cheerleading, Dance Teams and advanced Acrobatic classes. Wear any color leotard, bike shorts or dance pants. Beige jazz shoes are recommended.

Acro Express: An accelerated program for younger dancers. Includes classes in Tap, Jazz, Tumbling & Ballet. Wear any color leotard, bike shorts or dance pants. Beige jazz shoes are recommended.

Ballet: Students learn classical positions, barre work, centre floor, leaps & turns. Basic building block of all dance. Wear a black leotard, pink tights and pink ballet shoes. Hair should be in a neat bun.

Mini Express: A teacher placement Ballet/Tap/Jazz class for younger dancers continuing with their accelerated dance education. Members may perform or compete locally. Wear any color leotard, tights or dance shorts or pants. Tap, ballet and lace-up jazz shoes are also needed. Hair should be in a neat pony or bun.

Petite Express: A teacher placement Ballet/Tap/Jazz class for younger dancers continuing with their dance education at an accelerated level. Members may perform locally. Wear any color leotard, tights or dance shorts or pants. Tap, ballet and lace-up jazz shoes are also needed. Hair should be in a neat pony or bun.

Glee: Are you a Gleek? Class will include Singing, Dancing, Stage-Movement, and Production Routines. No experience needed. Wear comfortable clothing you can move in and black jazz shoes.

Gymnastics/Dance: This class will work on tap dancing skills in our dance room and then move into our gym to work on basic gymnastics skills on the different apparatus.

Hip Hop: This high energy class highlights popular dance steps seen in current music videos. Music and dance moves are always age appropriate, fast paced and fun! Wear comfortable athletic clothing and black, non-marking tennis shoes (like Converse) or hip hop sneakers to be worn only in class.

Jazz: Includes the latest dance moves with technique training in flexibility, kicks, turns, leaps & choreography. A great basis for school dance teams theater and cheer. Wear any color leotard, tights or dance shorts or pants and beige "Foot Paws".

Pre-Ballet: A perfect class for the younger ballet student. This class includes ballet positions, barre work, floor, leaps and turns. Helps develop coordination and grace. Wear a pink or black leotard, pink tights and pink ballet shoes. Hair to be in a neat bun.

Princess Ballet: An innovative class designed to introduce children to basic ballet positions and technique, through movement, literature and personal expression. Princess Ballet II is designed for second year princess ballet students. Wear any color pastel leotard, pink tights and pink ballet shoes.

Princess Dance: An innovative class designed to introduce children to basic tap, jazz, acrobatics and ballet technique, through movement, literature and personal expression. Princess Dance II is designed for students that have completed a year of dance. Wear any color leotard and tights or dance shorts. Tap and pink ballet shoes will also be needed.

Tap: Dancers will develop rhythm, coordination, clarity of sounds & training in basic routines. Wear any color leotard, tights or dance shorts or pants and tap shoes.

Tap/Jazz/Tumble: For boys and girls ages 3 –9. Students learn the joy of dance and tumbling in a combination class. A fast paced variety of movement make this class one of our most popular. Wear any color leotard, tights or dance shorts or pants. Tap and ballet shoes will also be needed.

Tap/Jazz: Same as above, except class concentrates on dance only. Wear any color leotard, tights or dance shorts or pants. Tap and black jazz shoes or Beige "Foot Paws" will also be needed.

Tumble Dance: This class is designed for the parent and child to take class together in a fun environment. Class will focus on loco motor skills, hand-eye coordination and basic dance and tumbling skills. Wear any color leotard, tights or dance shorts or pants and ballet slippers.

Zumba: Zumba is a combination of dance and fitness based on salsa, merengue, reggaetone. Fun and highly aerobic! Enjoy a fun workout while your child takes a class! Wear comfortable athletic clothing and non-marking tennis shoes.

Acro Express & Elite Acrobatics: An accelerated acrobatic performance group required to take a Tap, Jazz or Ballet class in addition to their acrobatics class.

Ballet Company: An accelerated program for dancers who will receive more extensive training in Ballet and will have the opportunity to perform. Ballet Co. students must be taking an additional Ballet class.

Hipnotic/Hipnotic Jr. Crew: An accelerated program for dancers who will receive more extensive training in Hip Hop. They will perform and compete locally and regionally. An additional Jazz, Ballet, or Hip Hop class is required for all company members.

Northwest Fusion: A Pre-Professional company for dedicated dancers looking for intensive dance training that will prepare them for a professional dance career.

Performing Company: A talented group of dancers who compete and performing locally and nationally.

Pre-Company: Students are selected for more extensive training in dance. Includes classes in Tap, Jazz & Ballet. Members compete and perform locally.

Pre-Pointe & Pointe: Students are required to take at least two advanced level Ballet classes in addition to their Pointe class, and at least one advanced level Ballet class in addition to Pre-Pointe.

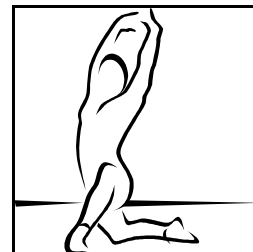
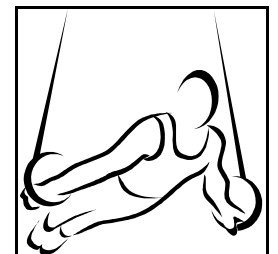
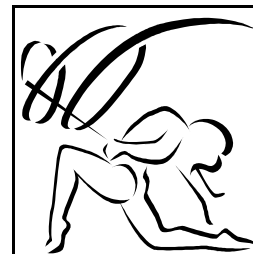
CLASS DESCRIPTIONS ~

Registration: A one-time family membership fee of \$25.00, includes full membership & member discounts to all programs in the facility. A re-start fee of \$10.00 will be assessed upon re-enrollment in classes starting September 1, on any account that has been inactive for at least a 12 month period.

Tuition: Tuition is based on 48 weeks of classes per year, an average of 4 weeks of classes per month. (*Some months you will have 5 classes and some months you will have 3.*) **Tuition is due the FIRST DAY of the month, not the first class of the month.** Late fees will automatically be charged to all accounts with a balance due after the first. It is recommended and encouraged that tuition is processed through the Electronic Funds Checking Transfer System. Our EFT system is 100% safe and confidential. Customers enrolled in EFT have the added benefit of charging pro shop items and other fees to their account. Westside Academy also accepts checks and cash. **Credit & Debit cards are not accepted.**

Recital and Mini Olympic Fees: Our year-end dance Recitals and Mini-Olympics are very special opportunities for our Westside stars to "shine." On November 1st, a recital fee will be charged to all dance students for each class in which they are enrolled. Recital fees include: costume, costume administration (ordering, shipping, processing), administration and staffing of event, & year-end achievements. On March 1st, a Mini-Olympics fee will be charged to all gymnastics students. Mini-Olympics fees include: uniform, uniform administration (ordering, shipping, processing), administration and staffing of event, & year-end trophies. Westside has a 99% student participation rate in these events and we are excited to see your child reach for the stars! Fees are non-refundable once processed.

Missed Classes: Students are encouraged to schedule make-up classes through the front office. We do not pro-rate for missed classes or substitute for tuition payments. Open Gym is available to use as a make-up. All make-ups are forfeited if the student drops from the program.

Adding, Dropping or Transferring Classes: The customer is responsible for notifying the office of any changes to their child's enrollment. All adds, drops, and transfers will be effective at the time of notification.

NSF Payments: A \$35.00 fee will be charged to your account for each transaction that is returned "Insufficient Funds." This fee is non-negotiable.

Referral Credit: If you refer a new family to our facility and they register for a class, you can receive a \$20.00 credit towards your account. Referral forms are available at our main office.

Parking: Do not park in front of the door, along the yellow painted curbs or along the fire lane. Remember: *Children cannot be seen behind or in front of a parked car.* For everyone's safety, please use designated parking spots! Do not park behind the Westside Academy vans, as they make many trips during our regular business hours. Additional parking is available in the Tigard Cinema lot.

Bad Weather Policy: Westside Academy follows the Tigard School District for weather closures only. If Tigard School District is closed due to weather, so is the Academy. If they open late, we open at 10:30 a.m. For Saturday/Sunday classes, please call the Academy or check your local news station. For evening closures, you will receive email notification.

Newsletters: In our on-going effort to keep parents informed of upcoming events, classroom activities and general academy information, an academy notice is distributed the first week of each month. Additional copies are available at the front office.
